MiX Vision ADPLUS 2.0
Customized Audio Alerts (AD Plus2.0)

Introduction

Loading customized audio notifications are now possible via USB flash drive.

Prerequisites

- Supported firmware ADPLUS2.0_V355 or higher
- Veyes app V1.1.4 (V1.1.3 should also work)
- USB Cable, Female USB to male mini-USB.



- USB Flash drive 1GB or larger.

Preparing USB drive

You need to format the USB drive as FAT32.

To manually apply new Audio files, please create the following directories before you copy the files to the USB drive

“upgrade/mp3/host” (all lower-case)

To automatically upgrade. (Without using the Veyes app)

”autoupgrade/mp3/host” (all lower-case)

To upgrade from another unit. (If you have slave devices that requires the audio files, currently not in use by MiX)

“upgrade/mp3/slave”

File name and Format

NB: New files created should be named the same as the “File Name” below.

- Format .WAV
- Channel: Mono
- Sample Rate: 16000 Hz
- Sample Format: 32-bit float
- Maximum file size accepted is 500kb but the average file size will be less then 100kb.

Loading new files to device.

- Copy your newly created audio files to the “host” directory in this path “upgrade/mp3/host”
- Connect your USB drive to the ADPLUS 2.0 using the USB cable.
- Power up your device and connect to the units WIFI access point
- Connect to the device using the Veyes app
- Navigate to General > Other and select Import Mp3 File
- You will get “Execution successful” if files are loaded

Question: I recorded my notification in stereo on a high bit rate, how do I change it using Audacity?

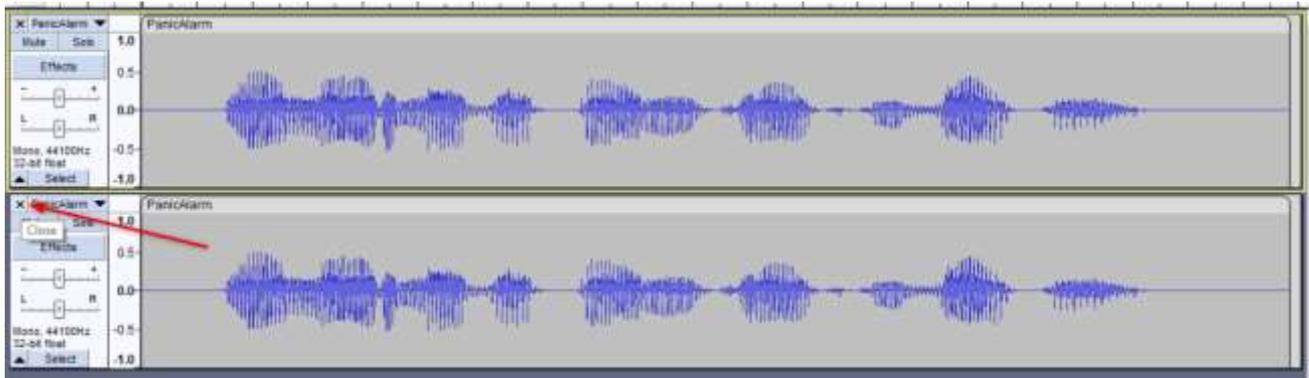
Drag your audio file to Audacity and view the parameter on the left.



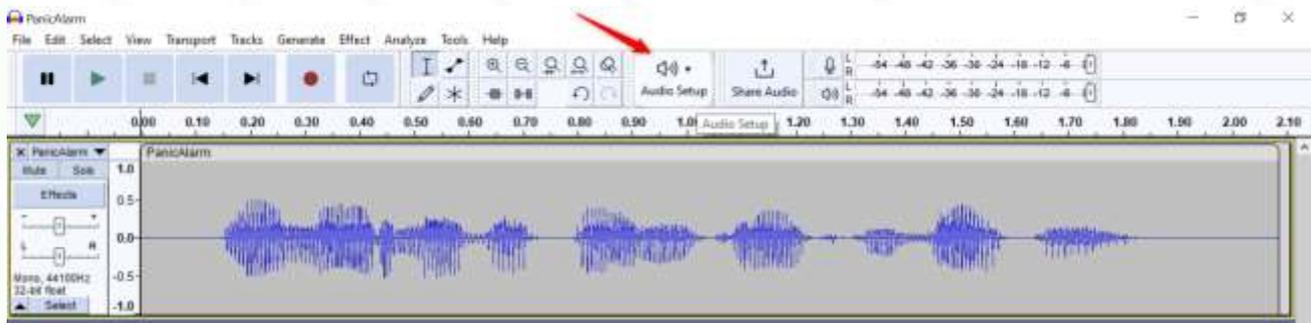
Split the Stereo recording to Mono, right click the left plane and select "Split Stereo to Mono"



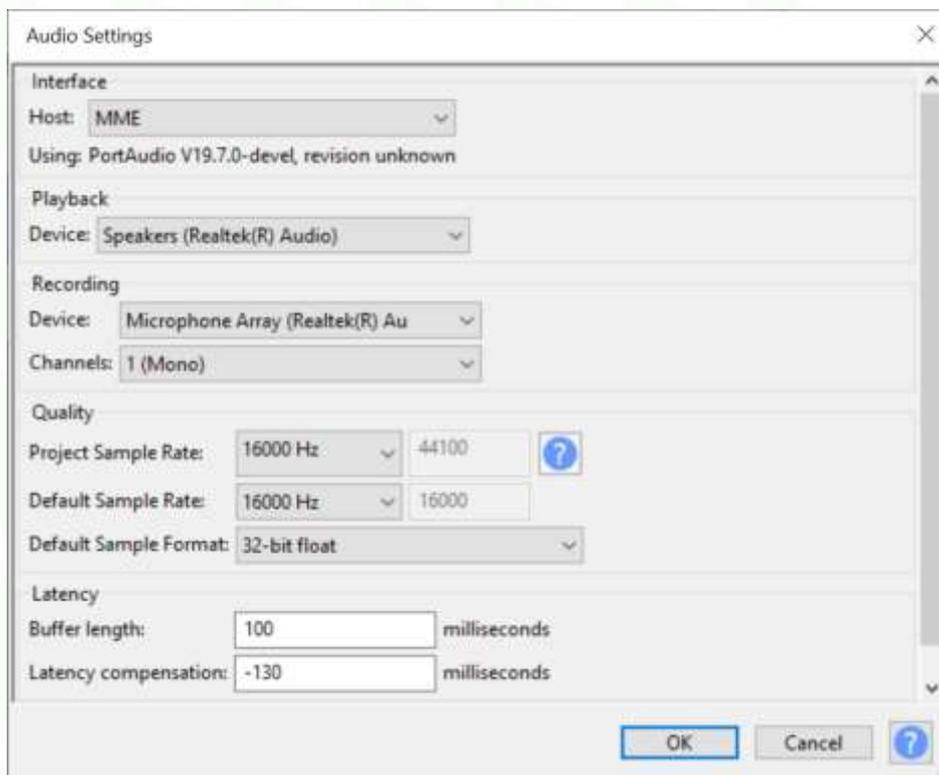
Close the second Mono line



Set your sample rate and format, select Audio Setup > Audio settings



Quality settings should be as below.



Export your file to .WAV format .
